

## **Plumbing Classroom Tools and Materials**

The following is a list of items that you are **required** to bring to your Plumbing Class:

- Lace-Up or Pull-On Work Boots – work boots are not required to be steel toed for our training facility however they must be made of sturdy leather
- Clear, Non-Tinted Safety Glasses with no reflective coating – you must be able to see your eyes through the lens (yellow and light blue lenses are OK as long as they do not have a reflective coating). All safety glasses must meet ANSI Z87.1-2003 standards and must be Z87+ rated. Prescription eyewear is allowed if it meets ANSI Z87-2 standards, otherwise, “over-the-glass” safety eyewear is required.
- Long Hard Pants (work pants or jeans) – no soft material such as sweat pants, jogging pants, etc.
- Shirt with Sleeves – short sleeved shirts are acceptable, but cut off sleeves are not allowed
- Hard Hat – required at all times while working in the lab area
- Work Gloves – required when handling rough objects or substances which might cut, tear, or burn your hands
- 2009 Uniform Plumbing Code book
- Construction calculator (Master 5, Model#4050)
- Architectural Ruler
- Notepad with lines, pen, pencil, and highlighter

Apprentices are not required to bring their tool bag and tools to class. Apprentices who choose to bring their tools to class, please mark and identify all tools and equipment (engrave or paint).
